

Issues in Auditing:

The Malaysian Empirical Evidence

The manuscript to be considered includes both published and unpublished work of the authors. The author may co-write the manuscript with other authors. Authors who wish to contribute their published articles must first obtain permission from the relevant publishers. However, to meet the objective of the book of readings, the submitted manuscripts and articles will be reviewed by the editors to ensure its appropriateness.

The proposed book will cover research in audit market and audit judgment.

Submission Guidelines

The manuscript submitted should be:

1. Empirical studies of both of qualitative and quantitative in nature.
2. Based on Malaysian data.
3. Written and completed within the last ten years (year 2000 to 2010).
4. Limited to 6000 words including references and appendices, as follows:
 - i. Format: TNR
 - ii. Font: 12 point, double spacing
 - iii. Title: Not more than 10 words
 - iv. Abstract: Maximum 250 words
 - v. Keyword: 6 words
 - vi. Referencing: APA style. All referencing should be complete and accurate
 - vii. Bibliographical notes: Full names, affiliation, email address of contact person for each manuscript should be provided in a separate cover page.
5. Highlighting the practical contributions
6. Accompanied with executive summary, following the specified format:
 - a. Objective
 - b. Design/Methodology
 - c. Key findings
 - d. Research implications/limitations
 - e. Practical contribution
